Did you know that in 2024; 1,930 dogs and cats were taken in by our county shelter? This is an unsustainable, crowded, and unhealthy situation for the animals, and the number of animals surrendered each year keeps growing. The Humane Society of Granville County (HSGC) along with the Granville County Animal Shelter (GCAS) work together to play a vital role to mitigate pet overpopulation and abandonment in our county. We approach the needs of each animal on a case-by-case basis, and work directly with pet owners to overcome challenges that may otherwise lead them to surrender their pets. This includes spaying and neutering so that we can reduce the number of unwanted animals that come to the shelter each year. These are animals that otherwise would have been on the street, killed by cars or predators.

My name is Angela Gooch and I am one of the founding members of HSGC, an organization that has served Granville County for over 30 years. This year, we will be hosting our annual Paws for Granville fundraiser event with GCAS on March 28, 2026, at The Barn at Vino. Paws for Granville is a dinner and auction that will raise dollars that are vital for spaying, neutering and much-needed medical care for the animals of Granville County. This is the 7th year we have hosted the event, and last year we raised \$17,886. We need your help this year to reach our fundraising goal of \$20,000.
